1. **HCR13** **MIGUEZ** **FIRE PROTECT/FIRE MARSHAL** Prohibits the state fire marshal from enforcing certain restrictions on businesses (Items #2 and 28)

HOUSE BILLS ON FINAL PASSAGE - NOTICE GIVEN - [4 items]

1. **HB37** **BEAULLIEU** **TAX CREDITS** Authorizes an income tax credit for certain businesses whose operations were interrupted as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic (Items #26 and 65)
2. **HB38** **LANCE HARRIS** **FUNDS/FUNDING** Provides relative to funding university, parish, and municipal police departments (Items #15 and 16)
3. **HB67** **CREWS** **FUNDS/FUNDING** Provides relative to state sales tax dedications for municipalities that defund their police departments (Items #11 and 16)
4. **HB78** **BEAULLIEU** **TAX/AD VALOREM-MFG/EXEMP**
Authorizes agreements between political subdivisions and taxpayers that may provide for certain payments in lieu of ad valorem taxes (Item #65)
