2. **HCR31** **LYONS** **PURCHASING/PROCUREMENT CD** To urge and request agencies procuring supplies, services, and major repairs on an emergency basis to provide for greater transparency and competition in such procurements where practicable

1. **SCR9** **CORTEZ** **UNEMPLOYMENT COMP** Suspends the provision of law providing for an unemployment insurance solvency tax. (Items #8 and #30)

2. **SCR10** **FOIL** **LEGISLATIVE AGENCIES** Requests that the Louisiana State Law Institute study certain matters pertaining to the Louisiana Trust Code.

1. **SB5** **HEWITT** **PORTS/HARBORS/TERMINALS** Authorizes Plaquemines Port, Harbor and Terminal District to apply for designation as a foreign trade zone. (gov sig) (Item #47)

2. **SB7** **HEWITT** **PORTS/HARBORS/TERMINALS** Provides relative to the Louisiana International Deep Water Gulf Transfer Terminal Authority. (gov sig) (Item #50)

3. **SB38** **BODI WHITE** **FUNDS/FUNDING** Provides relative to the creation, use, dedication, and transfer of funds in the state treasury. (gov sig) (Item #16)

4. **SB41** **JOHNS** **FEES/LICENSES/PERMITS** Provides relative to provisional licenses issued by the state fire marshal. (gov sig) (Item #32)

5. **SB44** **FIELDS** **COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES** Constitutional amendment to authorize the governor to appoint persons who reside out-of-state as certain at-large members of public postsecondary education boards of supervisors. (2/3 - CA13s1(A)) (Item #42)

6. **SB49** **HEWITT** **PORTS/HARBORS/TERMINALS** Provides for the issuance of bonds by the Louisiana International Deep Water Gulf Transfer Terminal Authority. (gov sig) (Item #49)
7. **SB50** **ALLAIN** **CAPITAL OUTLAY** Provides relative to the capital outlay process. (gov sig) (Item #15)
8. **SB52** **REESE** **TAX/AD VALOREM** Provides for credits for certain ad valorem taxes paid for the 2020 tax year. (gov sig) (Item #26)
9. **SB62** **SMITH** **TAX/AD VALOREM** Provides for the refundable portion of the inventory tax credit for certain manufacturers impacted by the 2020 emergencies and disasters. (gov sig) (Item #26)
10. **SB67** **REESE** **ECONOMIC DEVELOP DEPT** Authorizes the Department of Economic Development to provide an extension for certain job creation requirements for enterprise zone incentives and quality jobs incentive rebates due to the impacts of COVID-19, Hurricane Laura, and Hurricane Delta. (gov sig) (Items #26 and #65)
11. **SB69** **JOHNS** **EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS** Provides relative to emergency service plans of certain providers. (12/1/20) (2/3 - CA7s2.1(A)) (Items #2 and #38)
12. **SB72** **TALBOT** **TAX/INCOME/CORPORATE** Authorizes an income tax credit for certain businesses whose operations were interrupted as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. (gov sig)(Items #26 and #65)
