6. **SB34**            **PEACOCK**            **SPEECH/PATH/AUDIO** Provides for the Audiology and Speech-Language Pathology Interstate Compact (ASLP-IC). (7/1/21) (Item #37)
7. **SB53**            **MCMATH**            **EMPLOYMENT** Provides for the rehiring of nonlicensed persons by certain health care providers required to temporarily close during a public health emergency. (gov sig)(Item #28)
8. **SB71**            **PEACOCK**            **PUBLIC MEETINGS** Provides for participation in certain meetings by teleconferencing or other electronic means for legislative bodies. (gov sig) (Item #25)
