- SR 17 CARTER, TROY CONDOLENCES
Expresses the condolences on the death of George Rainey, oldest elected king of Zulu.
- SR 18 LAMBERT CONDOLENCES
Expresses condolences upon the death of Terry Edmund Edwards.
- SR 19 FOIL CONDOLENCES
Expresses condolences upon the death of James Raymond "Jim" LeBlanc.

House Concurrent Resolutions 2nd Reading

- HCR 7 COUSSAN ENERGY/OIL & GAS
Memorializes Congress to require the Federal Emergency Management Agency to more efficiently coordinate the removal of dislocated oilfield equipment after natural disasters in Louisiana
- HCR 13 MIGUEZ FIRE PROTECT/FIRE MARSHAL
Prohibits the state fire marshal from enforcing certain restrictions on businesses (Items #2 and 28)
- HCR 17 ROMERO SCHOOLS/FINANCE-MFP
Requests the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education to discuss possible adjustments to the Minimum Foundation Program formula in order to ensure adequate funding for school systems affected by Hurricane Laura or Hurricane Delta
- HCR 19 JOHNSON, MIKE UTILITIES
Provides relative to rural internet service (Item #67)
- HCR 21 WHEAT MEDICAID
Requests the La. Dept. of Health to submit documentation to the federal Medicaid agency to provide financial relief for providers of services for people with developmental disabilities (Item #28)
- HCR 22 JOHNSON, TRAVIS TRANSPORTATION
Urges and requests the Department of Culture, Recreation and Tourism, office of tourism, to study the feasibility of creating a bike and walking trail along the Mississippi River in Northeast Louisiana
- HCR 23 SCHEXNAYDER CONGRESS
Memorializes the United States Senate to confirm the nomination of Judge Amy Coney Barrett to the United States Supreme Court
- HCR 25 GADBERRY TEACHERS
Requests that the State Civil Service Commission establish the same or substantially similar sick leave benefits for classified employees serving as teaching staff within the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections, office of juvenile justice, as those provided for public school teachers injured or disabled while acting in their official capacity
- HCR 26 FREIBERG SCHOOLS
Requests that the Bd. of Elementary and Secondary Education, in collaboration with the Dept. of Education, issue guidance and policies relative to micro schools

SB 77 SMITH, G. GAMING
Provides relative to fantasy sports. (gov sig) (Item #32)

SB 10 HEWITT ETHICS
Provides for certain exceptions from Code of Governmental Ethics. (gov sig) (Item #48)

SB 15 MILLIGAN SCHOOLS
Requires first-day health insurance coverage for employees of public elementary and secondary school systems under certain circumstances. (gov sig) (Item #42)

SB 25 ALLAIN ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL
Provides for the transfer and use of funds from the Louisiana Main Street Recovery Program to the Oilfield Site Restoration Fund. (gov sig) (Item #19)

SB 40 HEWITT LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS
Constitutional Amendment to provide for remote operations of the legislature during a declared emergency. (2/3 - CA13s1(A)) (Item #5)

SB 47 PETERSON FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides for the allocation of certain funds in the state treasury. (gov sig) (Items #16 and #19)

SB 53 MCMATH EMPLOYMENT
Provides for the rehiring of nonlicensed persons by certain health care providers required to temporarily close during a public health emergency. (gov sig) (Item #28)

SB 66 CARTER, TROY PUBLIC RECORDS
To provide relative to the disclosure of certain personal information of appointed and certain elected officials. (gov sig) (Item #46)

House Concurrent Resolutions Reported by Committee to be adopted

HCR 3 BOURRIAQUE CONGRESS
Memorializes congress and the Louisiana congressional delegation to take such actions as are necessary to require the Federal Emergency Management Agency to grant Louisiana full federal funding for disaster expenses associated with Hurricane Laura or to grant Louisiana the ability to utilize alternative sources of federal funds as any needed match if full funding is not provided

HCR 4 BOURRIAQUE FEDERAL PROGRAMS
Requests the division of administration, office of community development, to include certain activities as eligible expenses in the development of its Community Development Block Grant - Disaster Recovery Program Action Plans

HCR 9 SCHEXNAYDER LEGISLATIVE POWERS
Suspends certain authority of the governor relative to the declaration of an emergency (Item #41)

HB 1 JAMES JUVENILES
Provides relative to parole eligibility for certain juvenile offenders (Item #58)

HB 2 JAMES CRIMINAL/RECORDS
Provides relative to the availability of certain criminal justice system data to certain nonprofit entities (Item #63)
