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Senate Resolutions 2nd Reading

- SR 21 BOUDREAUX COMMENDATIONS
Commends Jerry Romero on the occasion of his retirement from Acadian Ambulance after 44 years of service.
- SR 22 LUNEAU REVENUE DEPARTMENT
Requests the Department of Revenue to create a task force to study and make recommendations to minimize employee misclassification.
- SR 23 HARRIS, JIMMY TRAFFIC
Requests the Lakefront Management Authority to keep the westbound lanes of traffic open on Lakeshore Drive to vehicular traffic and to allow two-way traffic between the Senator Ted Hickey Bridge and Franklin Avenue on weekends.

House Concurrent Resolutions 2nd Reading

- HCR 2 JOHNSON, MIKE UTILITIES
Urges and requests the Louisiana Attorney General to investigate certain companies doing business in the state to determine if the companies have engaged in prohibited activities
- HCR 8 DEVILLIER ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE PERMT
Suspends the enforcement authority of the commissioner of alcohol and tobacco control for violations of COVID-19-related restrictions (Items #28, 32, 35, and 60)
- HCR 20 SCHEXNAYDER UNEMPLOYMENT COMP
Suspends the unemployment trust fund solvency tax (Item #30)
- HCR 24 ROMERO AGRICULTURE
Memorializes Congress and the Louisiana congressional delegation to take such actions as necessary to fully fund the Livestock Indemnity Program in response to the negative impact created by losses to the Louisiana livestock industry as a result of Hurricane Laura and Hurricane Delta

Senate Bills Returned from House with Amendments

- SB 1 WARD TAX/AD VALOREM
Extends the carryforward period for the inventory tax credit for certain businesses. (1/1/21) (Items #26 and #65)
- SB 30 MILLIGAN SCHOOLS
Provides regarding purchase of telecommunications and video equipment by certain educational entities. (1/1/21) (Item #42)
- SB 32 FIELDS COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES
Grants certain operational autonomies to certain public postsecondary education institutions. (gov sig) (Item #42)

Senate Bills 3rd Reading and Final Passage

- SB 57 LUNEAU REVENUE DEPARTMENT
Establishes reporting requirements for businesses and governmental entities using service providers. (2/3 - CA7s2.1(A)) (1/1/21) (Item #23)
- SB 61 MIZELL GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATION
Creates the office of broadband and connectivity. (gov sig) (Item #39)
- SB 67 REESE ECONOMIC DEVELOP DEPT
Authorizes the Department of Economic Development to provide an extension for certain job creation requirements for enterprise zone incentives and quality jobs incentive rebates due to the impacts of COVID-19, Hurricane Laura, and Hurricane Delta. (gov sig) (Items #26 and #65)
- SB 73 BARROW FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides funding and requirements for eligible rental businesses from the La. Main Street Recovery Program. (gov sig) (Items #16, #17, #18, #19, and #20)
- SB 75 MILLIGAN COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS
Provides relative to reporting requirements by certain Chinese enterprises. (gov sig) (Item #28)

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Senate Bills 3rd Reading and Final Passage Subject to Call

- SB 25 ALLAIN ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL
Provides for the transfer and use of funds from the Louisiana Main Street Recovery Program to the Oilfield Site Restoration Fund. (gov sig) (Item #19)
- SB 47 PETERSON FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides for the allocation of certain funds in the state treasury. (gov sig) (Items #16 and #19)
- SB 51 BARROW PHARMACISTS
Provides for immunizations, including the COVID-19 vaccine, to be administered by pharmacists. (See Act) (Item #40)
- SB 53 MCMATH EMPLOYMENT
Provides for the rehiring of nonlicensed persons by certain health care providers required to temporarily close during a public health emergency. (gov sig) (Item #28)
- SB 66 CARTER, TROY PUBLIC RECORDS
To provide relative to the disclosure of certain personal information of appointed and certain elected officials. (gov sig) (Item #46)

- HCR 9 SCHEXNAYDER LEGISLATIVE POWERS
Suspends certain authority of the governor relative to the declaration of an emergency (Item #41)

House Bills 3rd Reading and Final Passage

- HB 20 EDMONDS TAX/INCOME TAX
Provides relative to income tax deduction for certain educational expenses incurred during the COVID-19 pandemic (Item #26)
- HB 26 SCHEXNAYDER TAX/SALES-USE-EXEMPT
Establishes a sales tax holiday to provide relief for recovery as a result of Hurricane Laura and the COVID-19 pandemic (Item #26)
- HB 29 DEVILLIER TAX/SEVERANCE-EXEMPTION
Suspends severance taxes on production from certain oil wells (Items #26 and 61)
- HB 54 JAMES COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS
Provides relative to the acceptance of digital identification (Item #28)
- HB 77 DAVIS BANKS/BANKING
Provides relative to remote participation in meetings (Item #53)

Provides for legislative review of a state of emergency issued by the governor that extends beyond thirty days. (gov sig) (Items #1 and #2)
- HB 24 ZERINGUE CAPITAL OUTLAY
Provides relative to the capital outlay budget (Item #15)
- HB 39 ZERINGUE APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML
Makes supplemental appropriations for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 (Item #11)
