Provides relative to the capital outlay process. (gov sig) (Item #15)
- SB 62 SMITH, G. TAX/AD VALOREM  
Provides for the refundable portion of the inventory tax credit for certain manufacturers impacted by the 2020 emergencies and disasters. (gov sig) (Item #26)
- SB 69 JOHNS EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

To provide relative to the disclosure of certain personal information of appointed and certain elected officials. (gov sig) (Item #46)

Provides funding and requirements for eligible rental businesses from the La. Main Street Recovery Program. (gov sig) (Items #16, #17, #18, #19, and #20)

Provides relative to student discipline (Item #42)

HB 84 EDMONDS EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS  
Provides relative to the expenditure of federal funds received as a result of a disaster or emergency (Item #27)
