Provides for the reinspection of voting machines and recounting of absentee by mail and early voting ballots. (gov sig)
- SB 423 WHITE, B SPECIAL DISTRICTS
Provides for the city of St. George Transition District. (gov sig)
- SB 424 WHITE, B MUNICIPALITIES
Authorizes the city of Central to expropriate property by declaration for the purpose of maintaining and improving drainage. (gov sig)

Provides relative to articles of incorporation and qualifications of registered agents of certain corporations. (gov sig)
- SB 55 FOIL SECRETARY OF STATE
Removes requirement for telephone numbers in an application for registration of certain contract providers filed with the secretary of state. (gov sig)

| SB | 268 | JOHNS | BANKS/BANKING | Provides relative to abandonment of safety deposit boxes. (8/1/20) |
| SB | 312 | FESI | EDUCATION DEPARTMENT | Provides relative to environmental education and litter reduction section of the State Department of Education. (gov sig) |
| SB | 313 | PETERSON | LOCAL AGENCIES | Provides relative to exemptions related to the New Orleans Sewerage and Water Board. (gov sig) |
| SB | 390 | PETERSON | LOCAL AGENCIES | Provides relative to the public water system, the public sewerage system, and the public drainage system of the city of New Orleans. (gov sig) |
