SB 244 HENSGENS NATURAL RESOURCES DEPT
Provides for the Dept. of Energy and Natural Resources. (8/1/25)

Senate Concurrent Resolutions 2nd Reading

SCR 37 EDMONDS BESE
To urge and request BESE to procure an annual license for a 3D game-based learning platform that aligns with chemistry and physical science standards with real-world technologies to provide improved career opportunities for junior high and high school students.

SCR 38 EDMONDS POSTSECONDARY ED
Creates the Task Force on Career Alignment to study ways to implement education-to-career counseling to assist public college and university students to obtain employment in Louisiana after graduation.

Requires school systems to provide a salary increase for teachers and other school employees using savings attributable to the state's payment of certain unfunded accrued liability of the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana

HB 473 EMERSON FUNDS/FUNDING
(Constitutional Amendment) Provides relative to the application of state monies to the unfunded accrued liability of the Teachers' Retirement System of La.

HB 474 BRAUD MTR VEHICLE/EMERGENCY
Provides relative to emergency vehicles for coroners

HB 483 WRIGHT BANKS/BANKING
Provide relative to virtual currency kiosks

HB 504 COATES FUELS/LIQ PETROLEUM GAS
Increases the tanker truck registration fee applicable to certain trucks transporting liquefied petroleum gas

HB 505 CREWS AIRCRAFT/AIRPORTS
Provides relative to the repair and maintenance of privately-owned aircraft stored in leased or owned hangars in public airports or facilities

HB 570 CARVER COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS
Provides relative to minors use of applications

HB 580 ILLG PUBLIC SFTY/CORRECTIONS
Increase the penalties for operating a vehicle with fictitious plates and provides for specifications for temporary registration plates issued by dealers and the display of temporary registrations plates issued by dealers

HB 582 LACOMBE FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS
Provides relative to deferred presentment transactions and small loans

HB 669 RISER TAX/EXCISE
Continues a portion of the excise tax levied on cigarettes in statute

HB 677 CARVER ATTORNEYS
Provides relative to unfair or deceptive acts or practices relative to attorney advertising

HB 678 EMERSON FUNDS/FUNDING
(Constitutional Amendment) Modifies disposition of certain state revenues through repeal of the Revenue Stabilization Trust Fund and deposits of certain revenue streams into the Budget Stabilization Fund

Provides for the St. Tammany Parish Development District. (8/1/25)

SB 27 TALBOT TAX/TAXATION
Provides relative to the tax credit for donations to school tuition organizations. (gov sig)

SB 41 BARROW CHILDREN
Provides relative to child welfare. (See Act)

SB 42 SELDERS HEALTH CARE
Provides relative to perinatal behavioral health treatment. (8/1/25)

SB 95 CLOUD CRIMINAL PROCEDURE
Provides relative to electronic monitoring of certain offenders. (8/1/25)

SB 126 KLEINPETER SCHOOLS
Provides for school mapping data of public school buildings and facilities. (8/1/25)

Authorizes an income tax credit for eligible state employees that identify cost savings in state agencies. (gov sig)

Provides for carbon sequestration. (8/1/25)

SB 57 FESI TAX EXEMPTIONS
Constitutional Amendment to remove the income limitation for persons age sixty-five or older that qualify for the special assessment level for residential property receiving the homestead exemption. (2/3-CA13s1(A)) (1/1/27)

SB 86 BARROW JUDGES
Constitutional amendment to remove the mandatory retirement age for judges. (2/3 - CA13s1(A)) (1/1/27)

SB 115 DUPLESSIS TAX/TAXATION
Constitutional amendment to extend eligibility for the special assessment level for residential property receiving the homestead exemption to certain persons. (2/3 - CA13s1(A)) (1/1/27)

SB 164 WOMACK CONTRACTS
Provides for training of elected officials and employees of certain local governmental entities relative to public contracts. (gov sig)

SB 175 WOMACK PLUMBERS
Provides relative to the State Plumbing Board. (gov sig)

SB 183 MORRIS, JAY CRIME/PUNISHMENT
Creates the crime of unlawful accepting of a thing of value by a legislator. (8/1/25)

SB 196 OWEN, ROBERT COURTS
Provides relative to homelessness. (8/1/25)

SB 199 MYERS INSURANCE DEPARTMENT
Provides for the authority of the Department of Insurance in instances of fraud. (gov sig)

SB 200 STINE COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES
Provides for restrictions to international intercollegiate athlete's compensation, rights, and athletic scholarships. (8/1/25)

SB 218 DUPLESSIS CRIMINAL PROCEDURE
Provides relative to post conviction relief for defendants convicted by a non-unanimous jury verdict. (8/1/25)

HB	566	TURNER	PUBLIC CONTRACTS	Establishes job order contracting as an alternative project delivery method applicable to deferred maintenance of public facilities by postsecondary education institutions for certain work types
