HRs AND HCRs FINAL CONSIDERATION - [9 items]

1. **HR15** **WYBLE** **ELECTIONS** Memorializes the United States Congress to take such actions as are necessary to pass the SAVE America Act

3. **HCR14** **CARVER** **EDUCATION** Expresses support for federal efforts to eliminate the U.S. Department of Education and memorializes congress to fully cooperate with these efforts
4. **HCR6** **KNOX** **SUCCESSIONS** Authorizes the La. State Law Institute to study intestate succession proceedings
